The Eastern Star with its five points is composed of five equal triangles, which when arranged together, make a pentagon in the center.

Each sister chosen to represent one of these points, has her three sides: mental, physical, and spiritual. With the mental and physical sides she is free to communicate with those on either side. If the spiritual side is correct, facing the altar from whence cometh all help, it not only forms one side of the pentagon but becomes part of a larger triangle.

If any one point (or triangle) should fail to conform in length or size, or in its adjustment to all the others, or should it drop out entirely, the center which demands perfection, would not be a pentagon and the star would not be a star. But when each adjusts itself in true relationship to the others, there is not only a perfect meeting place at the altar, but round about the outer points is a greater pentagon of spiritual influence.

The radiance from a perfect star spreads out in a circle of light. Its influence is felt through space and time. It is an inspiration to all mankind.
